Call for Board Nominations

The North Eastman Health Association is a Regional Health Authority responsible for planning, delivering and administering a broad spectrum of Health Programs and Services to a multi-cultural population base of approximately 40,000 residents. North Eastman is geographically diverse, extending east to the Ontario border, north to the 53rd parallel, west to Lake Winnipeg and south slightly beyond the Trans-Canada Highway.

Nominations are now being accepted by the Minister of Health for Board appointments. These appointments will represent a broad cross-section of interest, experience and expertise. The nominees must have a strong commitment to improving the health system, to supporting the RHA and to improving the health of Manitobans.

Any resident of the North Eastman Region may nominate a person or persons, including him or herself for the board of the North Eastman Health Association.
